

POOL RULES:

- Lifeguards are responsible for the safety of the patrons and government property.
- Patrons must follow staff directions at all times to ensure a safe environment.
- Please walk at all times while on the pool deck. No Running.
- No diving in water less than 7 feet, including shallow end.
- Lap lanes are for lap swimming only.
- No hanging on, or sitting on lane lines.
- Horseplay (i.e. pushing, hitting, dunking, slapping with pool toys, shoulder riding, tossing of persons) is not permitted.
- NO street shoes or boots allowed on pool deck.
- Games such as basketball or volleyball are not allowed on the pool deck. Do not bounce water polo balls on the pool deck.
- No food or drink on the pool deck. Water only in a plastic bottle.
- No flipping off the side of the pool.
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear protective pants, such as swim diapers.
- The lifeguard has the right to remove any patron or group from the pool for unsafe conduct or behavior.
- At the lifeguard's discretion, certain swimmers may be instructed to wear a life jacket.
- The lifeguard can close the pool as needed for safety reasons.
- There will be no prolonged breath holding games or hyperventilating.

SWIM TEST:

- Good for one year
- Swim 25 meters front crawl or breaststroke with proper technique.
- Immediately pushing off the wall and treading water for 1 minute.
